Know the red flags

The most common types of scams will target you through fake emails, text messages, voice calls, letters, or even someone who shows up at your front door unexpectedly.

No matter which technique a scammer uses, be careful if you notice any of the following:

- Pressure to send money
- Threats with law enforcement action
- Told to purchase gift cards and provide codes as a form of payment
- Asked to cash a check for a stranger or send money via wire transfer
- Asked to deposit a check that overpays for something you're selling, and then send the
 difference elsewhere

Create strong, unique passwords

- Strong passwords are 8 or more characters long and include a combination of numbers, symbols, and upper and lowercase letters
- Use multifactor authentication when possible

Protect your devices

 Keep your phone, tablet, and computer up-to-date with the latest browsers, operating systems, and antivirus software

Keep your account information secure

- Go paperless with your accounts
- Never write your PIN on the back of your debit card
- Use trusted online payment methods, such as PayPal[®] or Zelle[®], instead of writing checks
